



# EMPOWERMENT SKILLS FOR EMPLOYMENT OF MIGRANT WOMEN THROUGH E-LITERACY!

## Description:

"E-mploy-Me!" is an innovative project funded under Erasmus+ KA2 whose main objective is to promote the socio-labour integration of unemployed immigrant women through empowerment and digital skills. As a starting point, it takes the absence of specific transnational initiatives in Europe that promote the integration of unemployed immigrant women through such innovative methodologies. Its fundamental target groups are socio-labour counselors and immigrant women, as "E-mploy-Me!" provides them with the necessary resources specifically designed to promote access to employment. As a result, the expected impact of the project is to boost access to employment for unemployed immigrant women.

"E-mploy-Me!" aims to contribute, in accordance with the Europe 2020 Strategy, to building an inclusive Europe in which access to employment is part of European growth and everyone has the same opportunities to access it.



## Online platform:

The online platform is up and running! In the context of "E-mploy-Me!" an online platform was developed, which is a gamified online social tool for exchange, e-learning, and mutual support to be used by the target group of the project: immigrant women and counsellors. The online platform ([www.e-mploy-me.eu](http://www.e-mploy-me.eu)) contains an e-course composed of four main modules:

1. Learning a foreign language
2. Job search, technologies & techniques to understand job demands

3. Soft skills for intercultural understanding and professional behaviour
4. Social integration

Each module contains useful information for the respective subjects and short activities to test the user's comprehension of the material of the module. The modules, as well as the project website, are available in five languages: English, Spanish, Greek, Italian, and German. The Online course for socio-labour integration leads to increased skills and competences in digital literacy and media, as well as increased use of social networks for professional purposes.

## Next steps:

On November 18-22, 2019, the project partners will attend the joint staff training in Nicosia, Cyprus, during which they will present the modules, test the online platform, receive feedback, and use their experience to organise trainings in their partner countries. The 5-day training activity will gather a total of ten participants from the partner organisations.
