After extended desk research, 4 reports of SE needs and challenges are now published online – one for each partner country; Poland, Italy, Greece and Bulgaria.

The Reports of Social Enterprises' Needs and Challenges are a result of review of the relevant analyses in the 4 countries and the available EU literature. The aim was to identify recurring needs and challenges for social

enterprises within various local contexts.

After presenting the main characteristics of SEs, stressing important legal aspects among else, each Report provides a valuable review of available research carried out in the partner country and by EU institutions, focusing on the needs and challenges in three identified key areas:

1. Recruitment, retention and internal training of SES' personnel promoting inclusive educational approaches and mainstream practices
2. Securing of training facilities and expert knowledge on communication of SEs' impact and community importance
3. Distribution of SEs' goods in a sustainable way visible for the community

In the end, the main conclusions and recommendations for the SE-Hubs vision for SE co-creation hubs as an innovative model attempt to summarize the regular SE needs and outline a few recommendations that will be kept in mind when building the vision.
