Third Transnational Partner Meeting: Palermo, September 2025

In late September, our team gathered in sunny Palermo for our 3rd Transnational Partner Meeting (TPM), hosted by our Italian partner PRISM. It was a vibrant, productive two days focused on what's next:

• Expansion of the Podcast Series

It was agreed that additional podcast episodes will be produced. These episodes will focus on practical guidance for using AI tools in independent language learning.

• Preparation for the Pilot Phase

The pilot phase, scheduled to begin in November 2025, was formally prepared during the meeting. The pilot will involve testing the project's materials – including interactive presentations and guides for teachers and learners – with target groups across partner countries. Feedback collected during this phase will inform the final version of all materials.
