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THE WELLTEENS APP: DONE!



The app has undergone comprehensive testing involving not only teenagers, but also psychologists, educators, and youth workers. Their valuable feedback helped confirm that the app is user-friendly, modern, and equipped with a wide range of practical resources designed to support young people's well-being. The successful completion of the piloting phase marks an important milestone, bringing the WELLTEENS app one step closer to supporting teenagers across Europe.

PILOTING PHASE: FIRST RESULTS

During May and June, the first pilot workshops for young people and youth workers were organised in Ukraine and Bulgaria as part of the WELLTEENS project. In total, 80 young participants (39 in Bulgaria and 41 in Ukraine) and 43 youth workers (32 in Ukraine and 11 in Bulgaria) took part in these activities. The workshops provided participants with the opportunity to explore the WELLTEENS educational videos and mobile app, share their experiences, and provide valuable feedback on the developed materials.



The results have been extremely encouraging: participants highly appreciated the relevance of the content, the interactive format, and the practical tools for supporting adolescent well-being.

NEXT STEPS



The final stage of the WELLTEENS project will be particularly intensive, with a series of **multiplier events** taking place in all partner countries. These events will present the project's key achievements, including the educational video series, the WELLTEENS mobile app, and the practical resources developed to support the well-being of teenagers fleeing the war. They will also provide an opportunity to engage educators, psychologists, youth workers, policy-makers, and other stakeholders, ensuring the project's results reach a wide audience and continue to have an impact beyond the project lifetime.

A major highlight of this final phase will be the **Final Conference** and the **Fourth Transnational Project Meeting**, which will take place on **7-8 September 2026** in Palermo, Italy. During these events, the consortium will present the project's outcomes, discuss the lessons learned, share best practices from the piloting activities, and finalise the sustainability and exploitation strategy to ensure the long-term use of the WELLTEENS resources across Europe.
